What It Is

Unlike our virtual workshop, our **IN-PERSON** *Dignity in the Divide* workshop is a facilitated, Scripture-centered experience designed to help your specific community navigate political and cultural tensions with wisdom, conviction, and grace.

Rather than simply offering generalized teaching on how to address relational friction, this live experience creates space for guided reflection, honest dialogue, and spiritual discernment around the real issues, ongoing conversations, and yes—even the disagreements—present within your group. Through understanding the hearts and stories behind differing positions and perspectives, participants will engage one another in ways that preserve unity—strengthening both personal faith and communal trust.

This workshop is not reserved for communities facing internal challenges. It is **equally valuable** for communities seeking to proactively form a culture of discernment and grace, equipping believers to engage a divided world with steadiness, clarity, and faithfulness

Who This is For

- **Churches, ministries, and small groups** seeking to disciple believers in cultural wisdom
- **Pastors and church leaders** navigating tension within congregations
- **Believers** who feel stuck between silence and reactivity
- **Christian communities** longing to reflect Christ without withdrawing from the world

What Is Our Process?

This live experience follows a thoughtful, Scripture-rooted process designed to help your community move from tension and reactivity toward understanding, clarity, and Christlike engagement.

1. Name the Climate & Surface the Real Issues

We begin by examining the broader cultural and political climate influencing your community, while also identifying the specific conversations, tensions, and challenges shaping your shared experience.

2. Examine Reactions Through a Biblical Lens

Next we'll explore how assumptions, bias and emotional reactivity can shape our responses, and turn to Scripture to discern a wiser way forward.

3. Move from “What” to “Why”

We'll then learn practical tools for shifting from surface-level positions to the deeper values, fears, and experiences beneath them.

4. Establish Principles for Healthy Dialogue

Next, we will walk through core principles that foster respectful, grounded, and fruitful conversation—especially when disagreement remains.

5. Engage in Guided Dialogue

Now, we'll engage in facilitated, free-form conversation using the *Dinner & Discussion* model, allowing participants to speak from the heart in real time within a structured and supportive environment.

6. Clarify Takeaways & a Way Forward

Finally, we close by helping participants name key insights, personal takeaways, and practical next steps—offering a shared framework for continuing these conversations with wisdom, humility, and grace beyond the room.

- Clarity around the key cultural and political tensions affecting your community
- Greater understanding of the values, experiences, and concerns shaping their community
- Increased awareness of reactivity and emotional triggers that influence responses
- Practical tools for moving conversations from positions (“what”) to motivations (“why”)
- Shared principles for healthy, respectful dialogue across disagreement
- A facilitated framework for ongoing conversation beyond the workshop
